Why Are Court Services & Workers the *First* to Be Cut?

The Judicial Council and the AOC are proposing to spend \$1.9 billion on a massive computer case management project – at the same time they are planning to cut back on the public's access to timely justice and on workers' schedules.

Alameda County Court workers are already dealing with a one day a month furlough, effectively cutting pay by 5%. Now they are facing layoffs to nearly 10% of their staff. A portion of the money the AOC plans to use on its new computer system could easily offset these cuts in court services and jobs.

Facing \$293 million in cuts, this year will be difficult for courts. But that's all the more reason for decisions to be made with accountability, transparency, and fairness.
