The membership is now in the process of the 2016 Executive Board Election (officers, vice-presidents of organizing, politics and representation, committee chairs, regional vice-presidents, county area representatives, and budget and finance committee).

While in the performance of your duties, union staff shall remain uninvolved and neutral in relation to all the above races and candidate election activity. No employee of Local 1021, with the exception of those assigned to work with the election committee and election administrator, shall handle any ballots and ballot-related material.

No union resources—on or off of work time—may be used in support of or in opposition to any candidate or group of candidates. This includes but is not limited to union copiers, faxes, phones (including union-issued cell phones), e-mail, etc. Please also see the attached memo on candidate forums held by chapters. Please inform your chapter leaders about these rules, particularly if they want to hold candidate forums.

Any member lists, e-mail lists, and/or leadership lists in your possession which you have acquired in the course and scope of your employment may not be used for these elections in any fashion.

Please be aware of the following language regarding elections from the SEIU Constitution and ByLaws: “No candidate (including a prospective candidate) for any International office or office in a Local Union or affiliated body or supporter of a candidate may solicit or accept financial support or any other direct or indirect support of any kind from any nonmember of the International Union.”

A “Nomination and Election Notice” will be mailed to members today. The election notice contains election rules, will answer most questions about the election, and has a toll-free number members may call if they have questions about the election. The election notice will be posted in all offices beginning today, and will be available on the Local 1021 website.

Violation of these rules could lead to the overturning of an election results and the violator may be subject to disciplinary action.
