Layoff Fight Update, March 5, 2026

AHS CEO James Jackson and the Board of Trustees Say: “We’ll delay the layoffs ... *BUT ONLY TO MARCH 23!*”

On Tuesday, March 3, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors voted UNANIMOUSLY to:

1. Defer AHS layoffs
2. Work with AHS to find a better, more sustainable way forward
3. Form a committee with Supervisors Bas and Miley, AHS “leaders” and AHS workers to explore options that work for our workplace and the community we serve

At last night’s Board of Trustees meeting, the Trustees ignored this vote, and AHS management announced they’ll only be pausing the layoffs only through March 23.

Let’s be clear: **This is a direct slap in the face to the Board of Supervisors, and a direct slap in the face to us.** We will NOT accept this. We’re reaching out to affected workers, and planning next steps. Stay tuned, because we’re in this fight to WIN.
