The Election Committee will post submitted statements, information, and updates electronically on the Alameda County General Chapter portion of the Local's webpage.

ELECTION AND BALLOT COUNT

The election shall be conducted by secret ballot via an online vote from Monday July 3rd 2023 at 7:00am to Friday July 7th at 5:00pm. To participate you must be a member in good standing, filled out membership card and follow the online instructions to cast your ballot. Only members in good standing are eligible to vote. Proxy voting and write-in candidates are prohibited.

The election results will be announced on Friday July 7th 2023.

Challenges: Challenges to or disputes arising from a Chapter election must be submitted to the Chapter Election Committee within three (3) working days of the submission of the committee's election report to the Chapter Board. Challenges must be submitted in writing and must cite specific violation(s) of the Chapter election rules and procedures, Chapter bylaws, or the Local 1021 Bylaws and Constitution. Challenges to the election will be considered valid only if they cite specific violations of election rules and procedures, Chapter bylaws, or the Local 1021 Bylaws and Constitution and if the alleged violation may have affected the outcome of the election. The Chapter Election Committee shall investigate and resolve challenges within ten (10) working days of receipt of the challenge. The Election Committee may order a re-run of all or part of the election.

Appeals: Challenges or disputes which are denied or cannot be resolved by the Chapter Election Committee may be appealed in writing to the Local 1021 Executive Board within five (5) working days of receipt of the Chapter Election Committee's decision. The Local 1021 Executive Board shall investigate and respond within fifteen (15) working days of receipt of the challenge. Challenges to the election will be considered valid only if they cite specific violations of the Chapter election rules and procedures, Chapter bylaws, or the Local 1021 Bylaws and Constitution and if the alleged violation may have affected the outcome of the election.
