We, La Clínica workers have been tirelessly working all through the pandemic to help our community & provide care for our patients.

Instead of showing up for its workers & the community, La Clinica administrators have been spending tens of millions on IT, management positions, and unknown items while denying workers decent raises and doing nothing to address the 24.9% vacancy rate and 18.6% turnover rate that hurts community services and causes burnout among workers.
